OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAYS	May 5 - 7 (Mon - Wed)
COMPETITION DAYS	May 8 - 11
TOURNAMENT WATERS	Lake Fork and all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to Lake Fork. Any water closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.
FISHING LICENSE	Texas License is required https://tpwd.texas.gov/fishboat/fish/
FISH SIZE/LIMITS	5 bass – 14 inch minimum/Lake Fork is a catch, weigh and immediate release event. Other details will be provided as the event gets closer
